## **ACTING FOR THE CAMERA**

Hone your skills as a production-ready actor. Classes are held Friday evenings and on weekends. Each program module runs for 4 weeks and can be taken independently or concurrently.

#### VOCATIONAL DIPLOMA

## **CINEMA PRODUCTION**

The fast track to launch your film career! This full-time, 9-month program is structured around weekly modules that provide hands-on technical vocational training. Students learn all major trade disciplines in the film industry and are trained to be career-ready by graduation.

#### **DISTANCE LEARNING OPTION**

Many film schools offer online learning, but at NFI we combine interactive digital learning with 3 months of inperson, hands-on training. Study the basics of filmmaking from the convenience of your home and put them to use on-campus and on-set, collaborating with other student filmmakers.

#### OCCUPATIONAL ASSOCIATES DEGREE

#### CINEMA

This 60-credit, full-time program spans 2 years of study, resulting in an occupational associates degree. This program educates and trains professional filmmakers and screenwriters through 15 specialized film courses and 5 film-related general education courses.
